

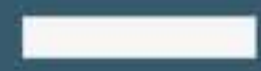

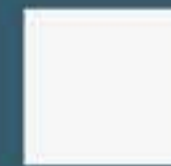

BUILDING THE WINESKIN

Dear friends, supporters, and Kaleo family,



When God spoke to my wife and I to move to Mexico in 2014, He spoke that we would see revival that would impact this nation and that missionaries would come from around the world to be trained alongside Mexican missionaries and be sent out to preach the gospel. When we moved to Reynosa, we began praying and preaching the gospel. After about a year on the field, we were frustrated that none of the things we had hoped to see seemed to be happening. During a prayer meeting with a group of pastor friends, I asked the Lord when He would send the revival He had promised. The Lord responded to my question with a question: "If I send revival now, are you ready to receive it? If I send you three thousand people tomorrow (like at Pentecost), are you ready to disciple them?"

I wept and replied that no, we honestly were not ready, nor did I know anyone in our region who was ready.

What the Lord told me next changed everything for us. The Lord told me to build a wineskin to receive the outpouring of His Spirit.

This simple word marked my thinking. It shifted our strategy and gave birth to the church planting vision of Kaleo. We began to focus on growing the wineskin by discipling leaders with the goal of planting healthy churches with the vision of multiplication!

The strategy is simple.

Reach the Lost.

Make disciples.

Plant churches.


Send missionaries out who will do the same.

"I used to believe that living with voices in my head was normal, but now I know I was wrong. I heard so many voices. The problem then is not what other people tell you, it's that you accept those negative words and live a bad life, wrongly believing them.... living for others, and nothing makes you feel good, everything seems bad, and it's like you are living someone else's life. But, one day, when I began declaring scripture by the advice of my Pastor, I began to experience positive changes in my life... God began to show me things but even then the voices were still there.

I decided to go to the Kaleo School of Missions and there I experienced something completely different, that is to say something supernatural, because I was so used to living with so many voices in my head, so many, like a snowball of negative thoughts. Sometimes I would reply to these voices "yes" or "no" or "that's not true", but the thoughts kept coming, including suicidal thoughts.

Now I understand that you can go to church for a decade but unless you have a genuine personal relationship with God and believe in who He says you are, its no use. Thanks to the staff of the school and the leaders of Kaleo I can now say that I am free of the voices that tormented me for so many years! Jesus allowed me to be completely free of this! Now I want to shout it to all the world about what God did in my life, even though sometimes, believe me, it's still difficult because people still tell me I'm crazy, but the difference now is that ok yes maybe I am crazy but I am crazy for my Lord Jesus! Their words don't hurt me like before because I have found my identity in God."

On October 3, 2021, Kaleo missionaries Michael & Jennifer Coots (along with their two daughters) returned to Morelos after 2 years in Monterrey, Nuevo Leon to help plant a new church in the capital city, Cuernavaca. The Coots family had served previously from 2016-2019 in Jojutla, Morelos with Arturo & Emali Higuera, helping establish the Kaleo Morelos missions base about an hour south of Cuernavaca. They started the new church in their living room with about 12 people in north Cuernavaca just two days after moving back to Morelos. They have a core team of about 6 Mexican leaders who had been serving with them previously in other ministries and are now committed to the local church. They felt like the Lord called them to focus on the local church plant and to raise healthy leaders for the first year. They also oversee the Kaleo Morelos missions base and help coordinate the 7 other Kaleo churches in central Mexico.



Within four months of starting their Sunday gatherings, weekly corporate intercession meetings, and a weekly leadership life group, they outgrew the living room and moved the Sunday gatherings to tents in their backyard. Without any real publicity or social media presence, new people continued to come every week, and the team decided to move to a larger rental space in mid-July 2022. They have started monthly men's and women's group gatherings and quarterly marriage workshops earlier this year. Pastors Michael & Jennifer have a heart for healthy marriages, families, and inner healing so the local team focuses heavily on relationship counseling, inner healing & deliverance.



Kaleo Cuernavaca recently celebrated their one-year anniversary as a church with approximately 50 people in attendance. They will be launching two new life groups in other parts of the city in the coming months and are now looking for a permanent home for the church and missions base for Kaleo Morelos!

Please pray that the Lord continues to bring them strong leaders to expand the Kingdom of God in Morelos and for a building that can serve as a local church and missions base!

East Africa

Six years ago, we were able to establish Kaleo Kenya with the initial purpose of creating a Bible Institute for training pastors in Western Kenya and a base for training missionaries and church planters from different East and North African nations. We began this vision in a very simple way, training pastors under a mango tree in a village called Nambale. The school began to grow and, over the years, God has blessed us. We now have received full accreditation from the Kenyan Government and, over the last few years, have been able to buy 5 acres of land on which to build dormitories, classrooms, and dig a well. We currently have students from multiple different East and North African nations who are training and studying to be sent out as missionaries and pastors. Our goal is to plant churches that plant churches. We started with one church and the Bible Institute, and from there, Kaleo International network of churches in East Africa has continued to grow. We now have 20 churches in Kenya, as well as 2 churches in South Sudan, 2 in Uganda and 2 in Tanzania. Our heart and goal is to continue sending out African missionaries. The next phase is to begin to run the Kaleo School of Missions there, alternating years with the Mexico base, to continue sending missionaries out all over the world. Our teams continue to establish new works and reach new tribes with the gospel of Jesus Christ.



2022 HIGHLIGHTS

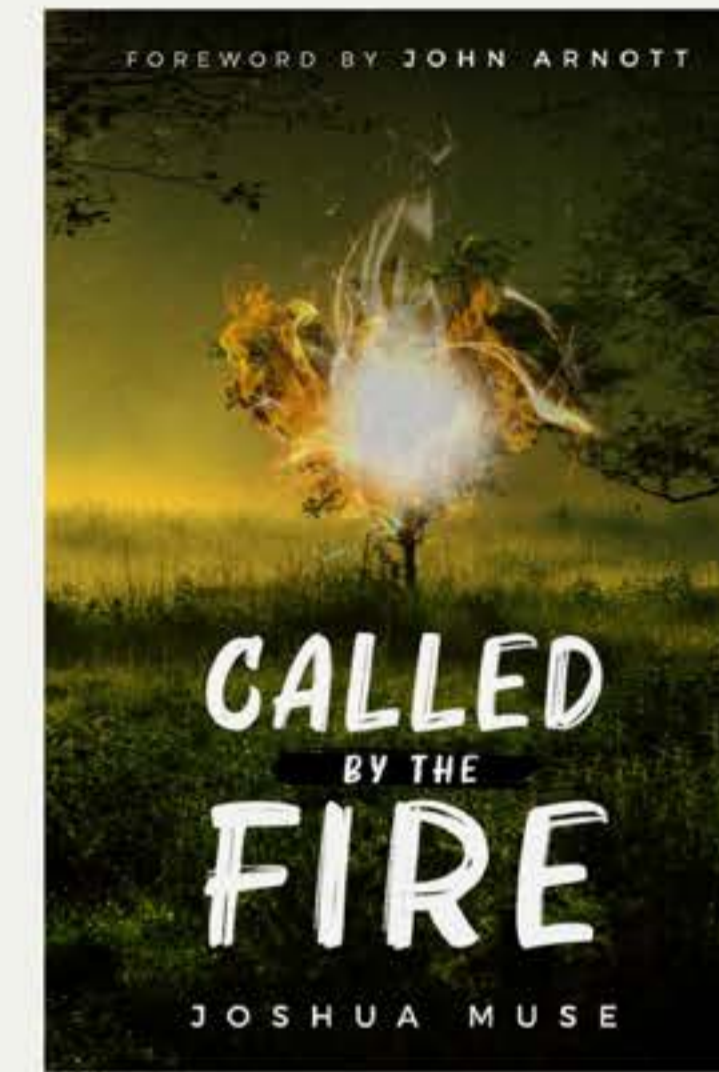
KALEO MIGRANT CENTER

In April, we officially opened the Kaleo Migrant Center in Reynosa to its first residents, all 150+ of them on the first day! So far we have helped over 1,400 people by providing a place of safety, where their basic needs are met, they hear the gospel, experience Christ's love, and are refreshed and encouraged in their faith. It is a work in progress and there is lots to do, but we have so many testimonies of how God has been working in and for our shelter and the people we care for.



TEACHING GLOBALLY

Joshua Muse has been traveling this year as an invited teacher to a number of mission's school, including the Scandinavian School of Missions, Lighthouse School of Missions (the Netherlands) and the Youth With A Mission Trailblazer Schools of Missions in Atlanta, Georgia (May) and Kona, Hawaii (November).

BIBLE INSTITUTE

This year our Bible Institute in Kenya expanded in properties, adding an additional 4 acres to our compound. We are currently hosting students from Kenya, Uganda, South Sudan, Sudan, and several closed nations. Many of these students will go on to plant Kaleo churches in their nations.



SCHOOL OF MISSIONS

We had our 5th School of Missions in Reynosa, Mexico, attended by Mexicans, Australians, Germans, and Americans.

LEADERSHIP SCHOOLS

This year we ran Kaleo Leadership Schools in Tennessee (July) and Reynosa (October). Many of the students were pastors and long-term missionaries. After the Reynosa school, there were week long bilingual intensive courses in Counseling and Worship.



MADRID ACADEMY

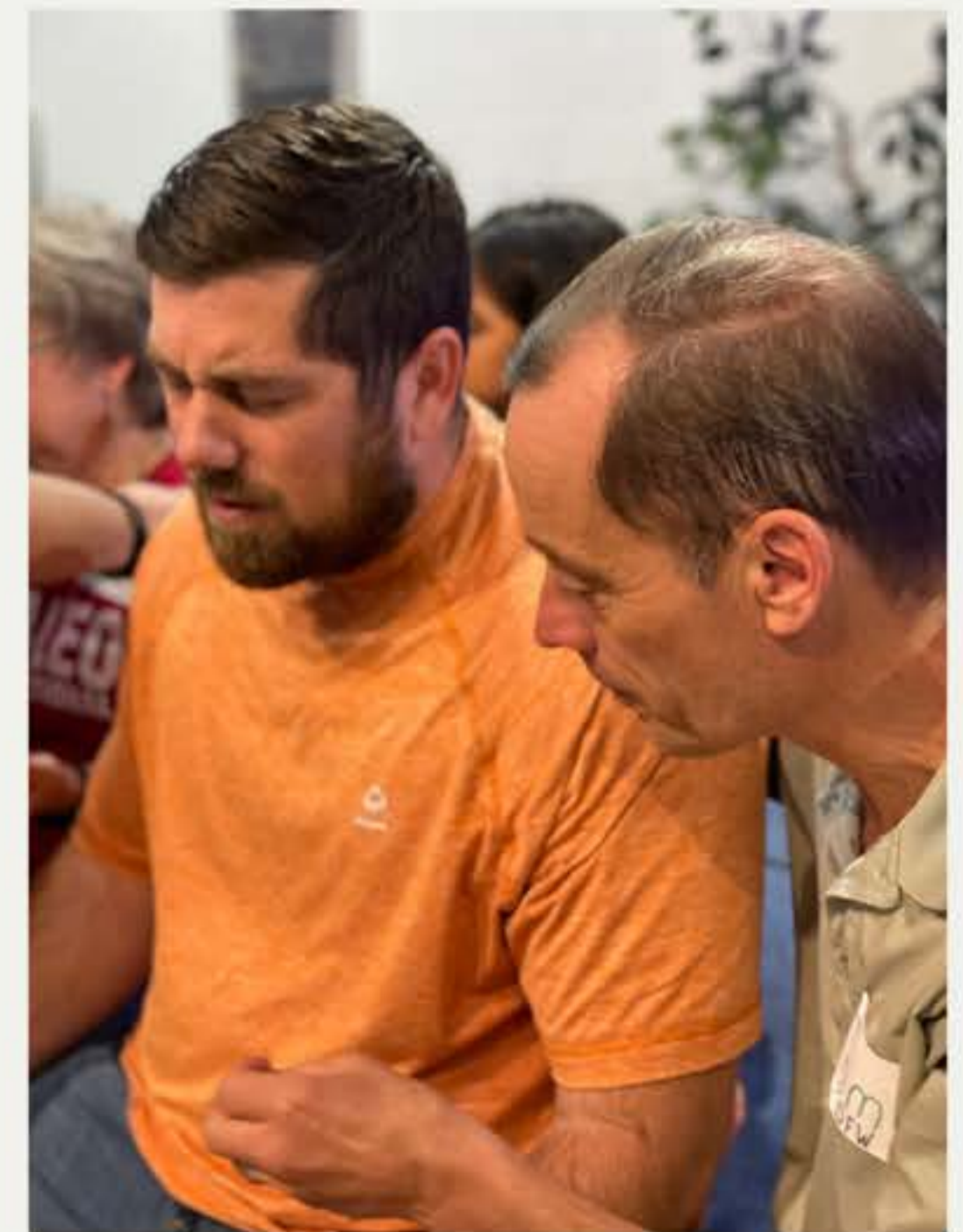
Since the planting of the new Kaleo base in Madrid, the Madrid Academy is now in its second year. The heart of the school is to see healthy leaders being raised up by training and equipping individuals to live a lifestyle of intimacy with Jesus and surrender to the Holy Spirit.

KALEO FAMILY GATHERING 2022

In November we had our annual family gathering in Reynosa, where the international Kaleo team and families came from various bases for a time of fellowship, to share testimonies, and to receive fresh vision. This year was the biggest gathering we have had yet! God moved so powerfully, encouraging and empowering us for the work He has called us to do.

The dates for next years' gathering are November 1-3, 2023.

NIGHTS OF FIRE (NOV 2022)

The Thursday and Friday evenings of our family gathering, we held what we call Nights of Fire under the newly constructed roof in our conference center in Reynosa. These nights are an open event with the intention of ministering to the city and making space for God to move with His fire. Many locals came, including those from both Kaleo and local non-Kaleo churches, along with the migrants from our refugee center. Because we had people from so many nations we did the services in English, Spanish and Haitian Creole!

God moved powerfully in miracles, signs, wonders, and salvations. We ordained new Kaleo pastors and water baptized many new believers! Testimonies are still coming in from these nights of the healings and deliverances God did. We are continually amazed at what the Lord is doing in the nations!

PIONEER MISSIONS

Please pray with us as we prepare to reach out to indigenous tribes in Mexico, North and East Africa, and Middle Eastern nations.

KALEO MIGRANT CENTER

Our shelter on the Mexico/USA border has now been open for over 7 months, and we have helped over 1,400 asylum seekers! In the new year, we hope to finish the construction of the second floor and additional spaces to complete the shelter.

CONSTRUCTION OF KENYAN BIBLE INSTITUTE COMPOUND

In addition to our Bible School, we plan to start an international School of Missions to train pioneering missionaries at our Bible School compound in Kenya. Next year we plan to begin construction on our School of Missions buildings.

DRUG & ALCOHOL REHAB CENTERS

We have several locations where we would like to build Christian rehabilitation centers so we can see Jesus transform lives permanently.
